

Notes from November 11, 2017

A quorum of the Cobmoosa Shores Association was not present on November 11, 2017, so no official meeting was held and no decisions were made. Information was shared as follows:

Members of the board present were Sarah Collins, Jerry Parise, Ed Dedic, Rich Campbell, and Rick Emerson. Rick Zane was also present and is a member of the Association.

The treasurer provided the normal report of financial activity and status of the budget. Of interest, \$2639.75 is still outstanding in dues. Most is from members who only owe one year of dues. A suggestion was made for the board to consider the addition of a "Late Charge" instead of or in addition to the percentage charged now. Further consideration will take place at a future official meeting of the board. Ed Dedic gave the treasurer \$77 which was raised from the auction of the street signs. This cash will be held by the treasurer as petty cash rather than deposited.

Tree work that was needed for the roads is now complete except for the oak on Paw Bowme between Shawbecong and Ottawatamie which will be done by the utility company. The salt/sand barrels have been filled. The roads are now frozen, so work on the roads is pretty much over until spring. Ed will be in touch with Pete Roskam about the possibility of staking Erie Trail where there is a drop off at the shoulder from the paving to avoid damage to the asphalt if the plow driver drives over the edge.

Progress was noted on the various building projects in the association. The Boersma garage is proceeding, so apparently set back requirements have been satisfied.

It was noted that many local events are being posted on the website's calendar. This can be very helpful to residents to plan their week-ends.

The Google collaborative project will be held until January or February when on line training for board members will be made available.

The dates for the meetings in 2018 have been published and sent to the county. It is uncertain that a quorum is available for the April meeting.
